## CABIN LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

\* You may bring **liquids**, aerosols and gels on board as long as they do not exceed a maximum volume of 100ml for each item, carried in one resealable, transparent plastic bag no more than 1-litre in capacity per passenger. The plastic bag must be presented separately from all other carry-on baggage at the security screening points. Exceptions from the liquids, aerosols and gels restrictions have been made for baby food, formula and other essential baby products. Aviation Security Officers may ask to see some proof that the medications you are carrying are yours and are necessary for your condition.

\*\* You can still bring **food** from home as long as it is solid in form. You cannot bring food that is a liquid, jelly or a sauce. If you are going to take your food items off the aircraft with you at your destination, make sure you are aware of the customs and biosecurity requirements in your destination country.

\*\*\* You can carry small **scissors**, tweezers and razors (up to 6cm) on your carry on bag. Bigger scissors and razors are not allowed.

\*\*\*\* You can buy **liquids from duty-free** once you have passed through the security screening point. If you are traveling directly to another country, you can still take duty free liquids on the aircraft with you. If you are taking more than one flight before you reach your destination, you may be screened when you change flights in another country. If you have liquids greater than 100ml or not in the 1 litre plastic bag (including duty free purchases), you may lose them at the screening point in that country. We recommend that you only purchase duty free just prior to or at the end of the last flight of your journey, or that you collect it on your return home.
